On his death, Philomena was told she must have the procedure or be thrown out and lose her 4 children. In fear, she took her children and fled back to her mother who welcomed them back. Her mother had heard about the school and encouraged Philomena to go to it. Philomena was able to get a scholarship and while at school by day, her mother cares for the children. Philomena is in her final year of secondary school and looking forward to attending university to study education. She dreams of becoming a teacher. The OAIC supports the school by providing scholarships and contributing to the salaries of the teachers. Loving our neighbours is at the heart of our M&S.
